



PLACE VALUE GAME

1. Review place values with the class. (Up to 1 billion)
2. Explain that you are going to play a game and that the winner must have the highest number. (Pass out place value sheets)
3. Roll a die on the overhead. Students should take that number and place it anywhere on their sheet (on the first line) that they wish. Remember, you are trying to make the highest number possible.
4. Roll again and again until all spaces are full. Find the student who thinks they have the highest number. Put it on the board.
5. Play the game together two or three times until they get the hang of it, and then have them play in groups of 4 or 5.

VARIATION: You may play for lowest number too!
